God's Covenant Promise

A covenant is a serious binding agreement, sealed in blood, between God and His people. From the beginning of time, God has been a covenant-keeping God. In Deuteronomy we read, "Know therefore that the LORD your God, he is God, the faithful God, which keeps covenant and mercy with them that love him (7:9a).

In Hebrews, we read that Moses "sprinkled both the book, and all the people, saying, This is the blood of the testament which God has enjoined unto you (9:19b,20).

God's covenant promises greatly exceed the value of any other promises. A promise points to the future. Covenant promises point to the future based on Jesus' completed redemptive work in the past. By His death and the shedding of His precious blood, Jesus made possible our complete restoration to all that we have lost through sin. A covenant promise is a promise that has the intrinsic ability to bring faith because it is based on a completed work. It is an absolute truth that is assured by the covenant-keeping power of His blood.

God's Word is certain. God's Word is true. Whatever God has promised He will do. God's

covenant promises have been sealed by the precious blood of His own Son. His Words have been exalted to a place of unequalled, overcoming value by the application of His own precious blood. The absolute trustworthiness of these promises go far beyond the limitations of mere words. They are God's holy, inspired, unfailing, unchangeable covenant.

God's Word is alive and powerful. It cannot fail. As you read, meditate and declare God's covenant promises, faith will leap into your spirit. You will boldly receive the substance, evidence, manifestation and reality of God's covenant promises into your life.

If you have not yet entered into a covenant relationship with God, you can do it now by praying the following prayer:

Father, I acknowledge that I am a sinner. Thank you for sending your Son Jesus to die on the cross to pay the penalty of my sin. I renounce my past life of sin. I accept Jesus as my personal Savior. Jesus, come into my life and make me a new person. Thank you for forgiving me and cleansing me from all of my sin. Thank you for saving me and bringing me into covenant relationship with you through your precious blood.

Who his own self bare our sins in his own body on the tree, that we, being dead to sins, should live unto righteousness: by whose stripes you were healed. *I Peter 2:24*

For I will restore health unto you, and I will heal you of your wounds, says the

LORD; because they called you an Outcast,
saying, This is Zion, whom no man seeks
after. *Jeremiah 30:17*

He sent his word, and healed them, and
delivered them from their destructions.
Psalm 107:20

GOD THE SON IS:

My Righteousness

This is His name whereby He shall be
called: THE LORD OUR RIGHTEOUSNESS.
Jeremiah 23:6b

My righteousness shall be forever, and
My salvation from generation to
generation. *Isaiah 51:8b*

For he has made him to be sin for us,
who knew no sin; that we might be made

the righteousness of God in him.

II Corinthians 5:21

Not by works of righteousness which we have done, but according to his mercy he saved us, by the washing of regeneration, and renewing of the Holy Ghost;

Which he shed on us abundantly through Jesus Christ our Savior; *Titus 3:5,6*

And be found in him, not having mine own righteousness, which is of the law, but that which is through the faith of Christ, the righteousness which is of God by faith: *Philippians 3:9*

For if by one man's offence death reigned by one; much more they which receive abundance of grace and of the gift

of righteousness shall reign in life by one,
Jesus Christ.) *Romans 5:17*

But of him are you in Christ Jesus, who
of God is made unto us wisdom, and
righteousness, and sanctification, and
redemption: *I Corinthians 1:30*

For with the heart man believeth unto
righteousness; and with the mouth
confession is made unto salvation.
Romans 10:10

And the work of righteousness shall be
peace; and the effect of righteousness
quietness and assurance for ever.
Isaiah 32:17

GOD, THE SON IS:

My Lord

Wherefore God also has highly exalted him, and given him a name which is above every name:

That at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, of things in heaven, and things in earth, and things under the earth;

And that every tongue should confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father. *Philippians 2:9-11*

Likewise reckon you also yourselves to be dead indeed unto sin, but alive unto God through Jesus Christ our Lord.

Let not sin therefore reign in your mortal body, that you should obey it in the lusts thereof.

Neither yield you your members as instruments of unrighteousness unto sin: but yield yourselves unto God, as those that are alive from the dead, and your members as instruments of righteousness unto God.

Know you not, that to whom you yield yourselves servants to obey, his servants you are to whom you obey; whether of sin unto death, or of obedience unto righteousness? *Romans 6:11-13,16*

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

And be not conformed to this world, but be you transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is

that good and acceptable, and perfect, will
of God. *Romans 12:1,2*

But it is good for me to draw near to
God: I have put my trust in the Lord GOD,
that I may declare all your works.

GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT IS:

My Comforter

And I will pray the Father, and he shall
give you another Comforter, that he may
abide with you for ever;

Even the Spirit of truth; whom the
world cannot receive, because it sees him
not, neither knows him: but you know
him; for he dwells with you, and shall be
in you. *John 14:16,17*

Nevertheless I tell you the truth; It is expedient for you that I go away: for if I go not away, the Comforter will not come unto you; but if I depart, I will send him unto you. *John 16:7*

But when the Comforter is come, whom I will send unto you from the Father, even the Spirit of truth, which proceeds from the Father, he shall testify of me:*John 15:26*

Know you not that you are the temple of God, and that the Spirit of God dwells in you? *I Corinthians 3:16*

Likewise the Spirit also helps our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.

And he that searches the hearts knows what is the mind of the Spirit, because he makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.

Romans 8:26,27

But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

John 14:26

GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT IS:

My Guide

Howbeit when he, the Spirit of truth, is come, he will guide you into all truth: for he shall not speak of himself; but whatsoever he shall hear, that shall he

speaking: and he will show you things to come. *John 16:13*

The former treatise have I made, O Theophilus, of all that Jesus began both to do and teach,

Until the day in which he was taken up, after that he through the Holy Ghost had given commandments unto the apostles whom he had chosen. *Acts 1:1,2*

This is he that came by water and blood, even Jesus Christ; not by water only, but by water and blood. And it is the Spirit that bears witness, because the Spirit is truth. *I John 5:6*

This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these

are contrary the one to the other: so that you cannot do the things that you would.

But if you be led of the Spirit, you are not under the law. *Galatians 5:16,17,18*

That the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the Father of glory, may give unto you the spirit of wisdom and revelation in the knowledge of him: *Ephesians 1:17*

I will instruct you and teach you in the way which you shall go: I will guide you with mine eye. *Psalms 32:8*

And your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, This is the way, walk you in it, when you turn to the right hand, and when you turn to the left. *Isaiah 30:21*

GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT IS:

My Teacher

But the Comforter, which is the Holy Ghost, whom the Father will send in my name, he shall teach you all things, and bring all things to your remembrance, whatsoever I have said unto you.

John 14:26

But God has revealed them unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searches all things, yea, the deep things of God.

For what man knows the things of a man, save the spirit of man which is in him? even so the things of God knows no man, but the Spirit of God.

Now we have received, not the spirit of the world, but the spirit which is of God;

that we might know the things that are freely given to us of God.

Which things also we speak, not in the words which man's wisdom teaches, but which the Holy Ghost teaches; comparing spiritual things with spiritual.

I Corinthians 2:10-13

But you have an unction from the Holy One, and you know all things.

But the anointing which you have received of him abides in you, and you need not that any man teach you: but as the same anointing teaches you of all things, and is truth, and is no lie, and even as it has taught you, you shall abide in him.

I John 2:20,27

And when they bring you unto the synagogues, and unto magistrates, and powers, take you no thought how or what

thing you shall answer, or what you shall say.

For the Holy Ghost shall teach you in the same hour what you ought to say.

Luke 12:11,12

He answered and said unto them, Because it is given unto you to know the mysteries of the kingdom of heaven, but to them it is not given. *Matthew 13:11*

GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT IS:

My Gift

If you then, being evil, know how to give good gifts unto your children: how much more shall your heavenly Father give the Holy Spirit to them that ask him?

Luke 11:13

Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name

of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins,
and you shall receive the gift of the Holy
Ghost. *Acts 2:38*

And being assembled together with
them, commanded them that they should
not depart from Jerusalem, but wait for
the promise of the Father, which, says he,
you have heard of me.

For John truly baptized with water; but
you shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost
not many days hence.

But you shall receive power, after that
the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and
you shall be witnesses unto me both in
Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in
Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of
the earth. *Acts 1:4,5,8*

And they were all filled with the Holy
Ghost, and began to speak with other
tongues, as the Spirit gave them utterance.

Acts 2:4

Who, when they were come down,
prayed for them, that they might receive
the Holy Ghost;

Then laid they their hands on them,
and they received the Holy Ghost.

holy Ghost fell on all them which heard

And they of the circumcision which
believed were astonished, as many as
came with Peter, because that on the
Gentiles also was poured out the gift of

GOD THE HOLY SPIRIT IS:

My Power

How God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power: who went about doing good, and healing all that were oppressed of the devil; for God was with him. *Acts 10:38*

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to preach the gospel to the poor; he has sent me to heal the brokenhearted, to preach deliverance to the captives, and recovering of sight to the blind, to set at liberty them that are bruised,

To preach the acceptable year of the Lord. *Luke 4:18,19*

But if the Spirit of him that raised up Jesus from the dead dwell in you, he that raised up Christ from the dead shall also quicken your mortal bodies by his Spirit that dwells in you. *Romans 8:11*

That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man; *Ephesians 3:16*

But you shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and you shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth. *Acts 1:8*

And my speech and my preaching was not with enticing words of man's wisdom,

but in demonstration of the Spirit and of power: *I Corinthians 2:4*

And when they had prayed, the place was shaken where they were assembled together; and they were all filled with the Holy Ghost, and they spoke the word of God with boldness.

And with great power gave the apostles witness to the resurrection of the Lord Jesus: and great grace was upon them all.

Acts 4:31,33

In whom you also trusted, after that you heard the word of truth, the gospel of your salvation: *Ephesians 1:13a*

Continue in my word, then are you my disciples indeed;

And you shall know the truth, and the truth shall make you free. *John 8:31b,32*

For all the promises of God in him are yea, and in him Amen, unto the glory of God by us. *II Corinthians 1:20*

Ministering Angels

Are they not all ministering spirits, sent forth to minister for them who shall be heirs of salvation? *Hebrews 1:13,14*

There shall no evil befall you, neither shall any plague come nigh your dwelling.

For he shall give his angels charge over you, to keep you in all your ways.

They shall bear you up in their hands, lest you dash your foot against a stone.

Be not forgetful to entertain strangers: for thereby some have entertained angels unawares. *Hebrews 13:2*

And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceives the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him. *Revelation 12:7-9*

The angel of the LORD encamps around about them that fear him, and delivers them. *Psalms 34:7*

Bless the LORD, you his angels, that excel in strength, that do his command-

ments, hearkening unto the voice of his word. *Psalms 103:20*

And David lifted up his eyes, and saw the angel of the LORD stand between the earth and the heaven, having a drawn sword in his hand stretched out over Jerusalem. Then David and the elders of Israel, who were clothed in sackcloth, fell upon their faces. *I Chronicles 21:16*

Then Nebuchadnezzar spoke, and said, Blessed be the God of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego, who has sent his angel, and delivered his servants that trusted in him, *Daniel 3:28a*

My God has sent his angel, and has shut the lions' mouths, that they have not hurt me: *Daniel 6:22a*

And the LORD sent an angel, which cut off all the mighty men of valor, and the leaders and captains in the camp of the king of Assyria. *II Chronicles 32:21a*

SATAN IS:

My Enemy

Be sober, be vigilant; because your adversary the devil, as a roaring lion walks about, seeking whom he may devour.

Whom resist steadfast in the faith,
I Peter 5:8,9a

And I heard a loud voice saying in heaven, Now is come salvation, and strength, and the kingdom of our God, and the power of his Christ: for the accuser of our brethren is cast down,

which accused them before our God day
and night. *Revelation 12:10*

And no marvel; for Satan himself is
transformed into an angel of light.
II Corinthians 11:14

Submit yourselves therefore to God.
Resist the devil and he will flee from you.
James 4:7

The thief cometh not, but for to steal,
and to kill, and to destroy: I am come that
they might have life, and that they might
have it more abundantly. *John 10:10*

And ought not this woman, being a
daughter of Abraham, whom Satan has
bound, lo, these eighteen years, be loosed
from this bond on the sabbath day?
Luke 13:16

And these are they by the way side, where the word is sown; but when they have heard, Satan cometh immediately, and takes away the word that was sown in their hearts. *Mark 4:15*

Fear none of those things which you shall suffer: behold, the devil shall cast some of you into prison, that you may be tried; and you shall have tribulation ten days: be you faithful unto death, and I will give you a crown of life. *Revelation 2:10*

SATAN IS:

Defeated

Forasmuch then as the children are partakers of flesh and blood, he also himself likewise took part of the same; that through death he might destroy him

that had the power of death, that is, the devil; *Hebrews 2:14*

And having spoiled principalities and powers, he made a show of them openly, triumphing over them in it. *Colossians 2:15*

And the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly. *Romans 16:20a*

Put on the whole armour of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places. *Ephesians 6:11,12*

Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

For I am persuaded, that neither death, not life, nor angels, nor principalities, nor powers, nor things present, nor things to come

Nor height, nor depth, nor any other creature, shall be able to separate us from the love of God, which is in Christ Jesus our Lord. *Romans 8:37-39*

Behold, I give unto you power to tread on serpents and scorpions, and over all the power of the enemy: and nothing shall by any means hurt you. *Luke 10:19*

And they overcame him by the blood of the Lamb, and by the word of their testimony; and they loved not their lives unto the death. *Revelation 12:11*

Whoso finds a wife finds a good thing, and obtains favor of the LORD.

Proverbs 18:22

And said, For this cause shall a man leave father and mother, and shall cleave

to his wife: and they twain shall be one flesh?

Wherefore they are no more twain, but one flesh. What therefore God has joined together, let not man put asunder.

Matthew 19:5,6

Husband to Wife

For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the savior of the body.

Ephesians 5:23

Husbands, love your wives, even as Christ also loved the church, and gave himself for it;

So ought men to love their wives as their own bodies. He that loves his wife loves himself.

For no man ever yet hated his own flesh; but nourishes and cherishes it, even as the Lord the church;

For we are members of his body, of his flesh, and of his bones.

For this cause shall a man leave his father and mother, and shall be joined unto his wife, and they two shall be one flesh.
Ephesians 5:25,28-31

Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.
Ephesians 5:21

Likewise, you husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honor unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.

For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands: *I Peter 3:5*

That they may teach the young women to be sober, to love their husbands, to love their children

To be discreet, chaste, keepers at home, good, obedient to their own husbands, that the word of God be not blasphemed.

Titus 2:4,5

I will therefore that the younger women marry, bear children, guide the house,

give none occasion to the adversary to speak reproachfully. *I Timothy 5:14*

Nevertheless let every one of you in particular so love his wife even as himself; and the wife see that she reverence her husband. *Ephesians 5:33*

Submitting yourselves one to another in the fear of God.

Wives, submit yourselves unto your own husbands, as unto the Lord.

For the husband is the head of the wife, even as Christ is the head of the church: and he is the savior of the body.

Therefore as the church is subject unto Christ, so let the wives be to their own husbands in every thing. *Ephesians 5:21-24*

A virtuous woman is a crown to her husband: *Proverbs 12:4a*

Unsaved Spouse

Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ, and you shall be saved, and your house.

Likewise, you wives, be in subjection to your own husbands; that, if any obey not the word, they also may without the word be won by the conversation of the wives;

Likewise, you husbands, dwell with them according to knowledge, giving honor unto the wife, as unto the weaker vessel, and as being heirs together of the grace of life; that your prayers be not hindered.

I Peter 3:1,7

But to the rest speak I, not the Lord: If any brother has a wife that believeth not, and she be pleased to dwell with him, let him not put her away.

For what knows thou, O wife, whether you shall save your husband? Or how knows thou, O man, whether you shall save your wife? *I Corinthians 7:12-16*

Thus says the LORD, Keep you judgment, and do justice: for my salvation is near to come, *Isaiah 56:1a*

Cast your burden upon the LORD, and he shall sustain you: he shall never suffer the righteous to be moved. *Psalm 55:22*

Widow and Fatherless

Pure religion and undefiled before God and the Father is this, To visit the fatherless and widows in their affliction, and to keep himself unspotted from the world. *James 1:27*

The LORD preserves the strangers; he relieves the fatherless and widow: *Psalms 146:9a*

Leave your fatherless children, I will preserve them alive; and let your widows trust in me.
Jeremiah 49:11

Honor widows that are widows indeed.

Now she that is a widow indeed, and desolate, trusts in God, and continues in supplications and prayers night and day.
I Timothy 5:3,5

Thou art the helper of the fatherless.

Psalm 10:14b

Ye shall not afflict any widow, or fatherless child.

If you afflict them in any wise, and they cry at all unto me, I will surely hear their cry;
Exodus 22:22,23

Fear not; for you shall not be ashamed: neither be you confounded; for you shall not be put to shame: for you shall forget

the shame of your youth, and shall not remember the reproach of your widowhood any more.

For your Maker is *your* husband;

Isaiah 54:4,5a

Because I delivered the poor that cried, and the fatherless, and him that had none to help him.

The blessing of him that was ready to perish came upon me, and I caused the widow's heart to sing for joy. *Job 29:12,13*

A father of the fatherless, and a judge of the widows, is God in his holy habitation.

Psalms 68:5

Single

And I will betroth you unto me for ever; yea, I will betroth you unto me in

righteousness, and in judgment, and in lovingkindness, and in mercies.

I will even betroth you unto me in faithfulness: and you shall know the LORD. *Hosea 2:19,20*

For your Maker is your husband; the Lord of hosts is his name; and your Redeemer the Holy One of Israel; The God of the whole earth shall he be called.

But and if she depart, let her remain unmarried, or be reconciled to her husband: and let not the husband put away his wife.

But to the rest speak I, not the Lord: If any brother has a wife that believeth not, and she be pleased to dwell with him, let him not put her away.

And the woman which has an husband that believeth not, and if he be pleased to dwell with her, let her not leave him.

Church

Obey them that have the rule over you, and submit yourselves: for they watch for your souls, as they that must give account, that they may do it with joy, and not with

Are you not then partial in yourselves, and are become judges of evil thoughts?

But if you have respect to persons, you commit sin, and are convinced of the law as transgressors. *James 2:2-4,9*

Thou shall not go up and down as a talebearer among your people:
Leviticus 19:16a

A talebearer reveals secrets: but he that
is of a faithful spirit conceals the matter.

Proverbs 11:13

He that covers a transgression seeks
love; but he that repeats a matter
separates very friends.

Proverbs 17:9

If any man among you seem to be
religious, and bridles not his tongue, but
deceives his own heart, this man's religion
is vain.

James 1:26

For he that will love life, and see good
days, let him refrain his tongue from evil,
and his lips that they speak no guile:

I Peter 3:10

Where no wood is, there the fire goes
out: so where there is no talebearer, the
strife ceases.

As coals are to burning coals, and wood to fire; so is a contentious man to kindle strife.

every man truth with his neighbor:
Ephesians 4:24,25a

A righteous man hates lying: but a wicked man is loathsome, and cometh to shame. *Proverbs 13:5*

He that works deceit shall not dwell within my house: he that tells lies shall not tarry in my sight. *Psalm 101:7*

These six things doth the LORD hate: yea, seven are an abomination unto him:

A proud look, a lying tongue, and hands that shed innocent blood,

An heart that devises wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief,

A false witness that speaks lies, and he that sows discord among brethren.

Proverbs 6:16-19

But Peter said, Ananias, why has Satan filled your heart to lie to the Holy Ghost, and to keep back part of the price of the land?

Whiles it remained, was it not your own? and after it was sold, was it not in your own power? why have you conceived this thing in your heart? you have not lied unto men, but unto God.

Acts 5:3,4

Deliver my soul, O LORD, from lying lips, and from a deceitful tongue.

Psalms 120:2

Vengeance

Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but rather give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance is mine; I will repay, says the Lord.

Romans 12:19

Thou shall not avenge, nor bear any
grudge against the children of your
people, but you shall love your neighbor
as yourself: *Leviticus 19:18a*

A soft answer turns away wrath: but
grievous words stir up anger.
Proverbs 15:1

Having a good conscience; that,
whereas they speak evil of you, as of
evildoers, they may be ashamed that
falsely accuse your good conversation in
Christ.

For it is better, if the will of God be so,
that you suffer for well doing, than for
evil doing. *I Peter 3:16,17*

But I say unto you, Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you;

That you may be the children of your
Father which is in heaven:

Matthew 5:38-45

Lust

Dearly beloved, I beseech you as
strangers and pilgrims, abstain from
fleshly lusts, which war against the soul;

I Peter 2:11

That he no longer should live the rest of
his time in the flesh to the lusts of men,
but to the will of God.

I Peter 4:2

Among whom also we all had our
conversation in times past in the lusts of
our flesh, fulfilling the desires of the flesh
and of the mind; and were by nature the
children of wrath, even as others.

Ephesians 2:3

For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

For this you know, that no whoremonger, nor unclean person, nor covetous man, who is an idolater, has any inheritance in the kingdom of Christ and of God. *Ephesians 5:3,5*

But whoso committed adultery with a woman lacks understanding: he that doeth it destroys his own soul.

A wound and dishonor shall he get; and his reproach shall not be wiped away. *Proverbs 6:32,33*

Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know you not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. *James 4:4*

Nevertheless, to avoid fornication, let every man have his own wife, and let every woman have her own husband.

Marriage is honorable in all, and the bed undefiled:

Hebrews 13:4a

Know you not that your bodies are the members of Christ? shall I then take the members of Christ, and make them the members of an harlot? God forbid.

What? know you not that he which is joined to an harlot is one body? for two, says he, shall be one flesh.

But he that is joined unto the Lord is one spirit.

Flee fornication. *I Corinthians 6:15-18a*

Sexual Perversion

Know you not that the unrighteous shall not inherit the kingdom of God? Be not deceived: neither fornicators, nor idolaters, nor adulterers, nor effeminate, nor abusers of themselves with mankind

Nor thieves, nor covetous, nor drunkards, nor revilers, or extortionists, shall inherit the kingdom of God.

I Corinthians 6:9,10

Professing themselves to be wise, they became fools,

Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonor their own bodies between themselves:

Who changed the truth of God into a lie, and worshipped and served the

creature more than the Creator, who is blessed for ever. Amen

For this cause God gave them up unto vile affections: for even their women did change the natural use into that which is against nature:

And likewise also the men, leaving the natural use of the woman, burned in their lust one toward another; men with men working that which is unseemly, and receiving in themselves that recompense of their error which was meet.

And even as they did not like to retain God in their knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind,

Romans 1:22,24-28

Set your affection on things above, not on things on the earth.

Mortify therefore your members which are upon the earth; fornication,

uncleanness, inordinate affection, evil concupiscence, and covetousness, which is idolatry: *Colossians 3:2,5*

For this is the will of God, even your sanctification, that you should abstain from fornication:

That every one of you should know how to possess his vessel in sanctification and honor; *I Thessalonians 4:3,4*

Separation From World

Love not the world, neither the things that are in the world. If any man love the world, the love of the Father is not in him.

For all that is in the world, the lust of the flesh, and the lust of the eyes, and the pride of life, is not of the Father, but is of the world.

And the world passes away, and the lust thereof: but he that doeth the will of God abides for ever. *I John 2:15-17*

Ye adulterers and adulteresses, know you not that the friendship of the world is enmity with God? whosoever therefore will be a friend of the world is the enemy of God. *James 4:4*

For what is a man profited, if he shall gain the whole world, and lose his own soul? or what shall a man give in exchange for his soul? *Matthew 16:26*

If you were of the world, the world would love his own: but because you are not of the world, but I have chosen you out of the world, therefore the world hates you. *John 15:19*

Set your affections on things above, not
on things on the earth. *Colossians 3:2*

No man that wars entangles himself
with the affairs of this life; that he may
please him who has chosen him to be a
soldier.

If we suffer, we shall also reign with
him: if we deny him, he also will deny us:
II Timothy 2:4,12

And be not conformed to this world:
but be you transformed by the renewing
of your mind, that you may prove what is
that good, and acceptable, and perfect,

Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us, *Hebrews 12:1*

Indecision

And Elijah came unto all the people, and said, How long halt you between two opinions? if the LORD be God, follow him:

I Kings 18:21a

No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.

Matthew 6:24

Draw nigh to God, and he will draw nigh to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double minded.

He staggered not at the promise of God through unbelief; but was strong in faith, giving glory to God;

And being fully persuaded that, what he had promised, he was able also to perform.

And therefore it was imputed to him for righteousness. *Romans 4:20-22*

Worry

Therefore I say unto you, Take no thought for your life, what you shall eat; neither for the body, what you shall put on.

The life is more than meat, and the body is more than raiment.

Consider the ravens: for they neither sow nor reap; which neither have storehouse nor barn; and God feeds them: how much more are you better than the fowls?

And which of you with taking thought can add to his stature one cubit?

If you then be not able to do that thing which is least, why take you thought for the rest?

Consider the lilies how they grow: they toil not, they spin not; and yet I say unto you, that Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.

If then God so clothe the grass, which is today in the field, and tomorrow is cast into the oven; how much more will he clothe you, O you of little faith?

Luke 12:22b-28

Casting all your care upon him; for he cares for you.

I Peter 5:7

My God shall supply all your need according to his riches in glory by Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:19

Thou wilt keep him in perfect peace, whose mind is stayed on you: because he trusts in you.

Trust you in the LORD for ever; for in the LORD JEHOVAH is everlasting strength:

Then shall you prosper, if you takes heed to fulfill the statutes and judgments which the LORD charged Moses with concerning Israel: be strong, and of good courage; dread not, nor be dismayed. *I Chronicles 22:13*

Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen your heart: wait, I say, on the LORD. *Psalms 27:14*

Deliverance

And it shall come to pass, that whosoever shall call on the name of the LORD shall be delivered: *Joel 2:32a*

Charity suffers long, and is kind; charity envies not; charity vaunted not itself, is not puffed up,

Does not behave itself unseemly, seeks not her own, is not easily provoked, thinks no evil;

Rejoices not in iniquity, but rejoices in the truth;

Bears all things, believeth all things, hopes all things, endures all things.

And now abides faith, hope, charity, these three; but the greatest of these is charity. *I Corinthians 13:4-7,13*

This is my commandment, That you love one another, as I have loved you.

Greater love has no man than this, that a man lay down his life for his friends.

These things I command you, that you love one another. *John 15:12,13,17*

Longsuffering

The fruit of the spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith, Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law. *Galatians 5:22,23*

I therefore, the prisoner of the Lord, beseech you that you walk worthy of the vocation wherewith you are called.

With all lowliness and meekness, with longsuffering, forbearing one another in love; *Ephesians 4:1,2*

For this cause I obtained mercy, that in me first Jesus Christ might show forth all longsuffering, for a pattern to them which should hereafter believe on him to life everlasting. *I Timothy 1:16*

Put on therefore, as the elect of God,
holy and beloved, bowels of mercies,
kindness, humbleness of mind, meekness,
longsuffering;

Forbearing one another, and forgiving
one another, *Colossians 3:12,13a*

Lie not one to another, seeing that you
have put off the old man with his deeds;

And have put on the new man, which is
renewed in knowledge after the image of
him that created him:

Strengthened with all might, according
to his glorious power, unto all patience
and longsuffering with joyfulness;

Colossians 1:9-11

I charge you therefore before God, and
the Lord Jesus Christ, who shall judge the
quick and the dead at his appearing and
his kingdom;

Preach the word; be instant in season,
out of season; reprove, rebuke, exhort
with all longsuffering and doctrine.

2 Timothy 41,:2

Patience

Wait on the Lord: be of good courage,
and he shall strengthen your heart: wait, I
say, on the Lord.

For the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men,

But love you your enemies, and do good, and lend, hoping for nothing again; and your reward shall be great, and you shall be the children of the Highest: for he

is kind unto the unthankful and to the
evil. *Luke 6:32,35*

This is my commandment, That you
love one another, as I have loved you.

Greater love has no man than this, that
a man lay down his life for his friends.

These things I command you, that you
love one another. *John 15:12,13,17*

The love of God is shed abroad in our
hearts by the Holy Ghost which is given
unto us. *Romans 5:5b*

And we know that all things work
together for good to them that love God,
to them who are the called according to
his purpose. *Romans 8:28*

But as it is written, Eye has not seen,
nor ear heard, neither have entered into
the heart of man, the things which God

has prepared for them that love him.

Love your enemies, bless them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; *Matthew 5:44b*

Knowing that whatsoever good thing any man doeth, the same shall he receive of the Lord, whether he be bond or free.

Live by Faith

Who though faith subdued kingdoms,
wrought righteousness, obtained
promises, stopped the mouths of lions,

Quenched the violence of fire, escaped
the edge of the sword, out of weakness
were made strong, waxed valiant in fight,
turned to flight the armies of the aliens.

Hebrews 11:33,34

But without faith it is impossible to
please him: for he that cometh to God
must believe that he is, and that he is a
rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Hebrews 11:6

Live in Power of His Spirit

Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto you, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God. *John 3:5*

Not that we are sufficient of ourselves to think any thing as of ourselves; but our sufficiency is of God;

Who also has made us able ministers of the new testament; not of the letter, but of the spirit: for the letter kills, but the spirit gives life. *II Corinthians 3:5,6*

It is the spirit that quickens *John 6:63a*

Walk in the Spirit, and you shall not fulfill the lust of the flesh.

For the flesh lusts against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh: and these

are contrary the one to the other: so that you cannot do the things that you would.

Galatians 5:16b,17

There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God.

Romans 8:1,14

God anointed Jesus of Nazareth with the Holy Ghost and with power:

Acts 10:38

Ye shall receive power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: *Acts 1:8a*

But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, gentleness, goodness, faith,

Meekness, temperance: against such there is no law.

If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit. *Galatians 5:22,23,25*

Be Conformed to His Image

I am crucified with Christ: nevertheless I live; yet not I, but Christ lives in me: and the life which I now live in the flesh I live by the faith of the Son of God, who loved me, and gave himself for me.

Galatians 2:20

Lie not one to another, seeing that you have put off the old man with his deeds;

And have put on the new man, which is renewed in knowledge after the image of him that created him: *Colossians 3:9,10*

What? know you not that your body is the temple of the Holy Ghost which is in you, which you have of God, and you are not your own?

For you are bought with a price: therefore glorify God in your body, and in your spirit, which are God's.

I Corinthians 6:19,20

I beseech you therefore, brethren, by the mercies of God, that you present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable unto God, which is your reasonable service.

And be not conformed to this world: but be you transformed by the renewing of your mind, that you may prove what is that good, and acceptable and perfect, will of God.

For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate to be conformed to the image of his Son,
Romans 8:29a

And as we have borne the image of the earthy, we shall also bear the image of the heavenly.
1 Corinthians 15:49

But we all, with open face beholding as in a glass the glory of the Lord, are changed into the same image from glory to glory, even as by the Spirit of the Lord.
II Corinthians 3:18

Live in Victory

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might.

Put on the whole armour of God, that you may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil.

For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high places.

Wherefore take unto you the whole armour of God, that you may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand.

Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness;

And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace;

Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith you shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked.

And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God:

Ephesians 6:10-17

Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? shall tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

Nay, in all these things we are more than conquerors through him that loved us.

Romans 8:35,37

No weapon that is formed against you shall prosper; and every tongue that shall rise against you in judgment you shall condemn. This is the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness is of me, says the LORD.

Isaiah 54:17

For whatsoever is born of God overcomes the world: and this is the victory that overcomes the world, even our faith.

I John 5:4

For the preaching of the cross is to them that perish foolishness; but unto us which are saved it is the power of God.

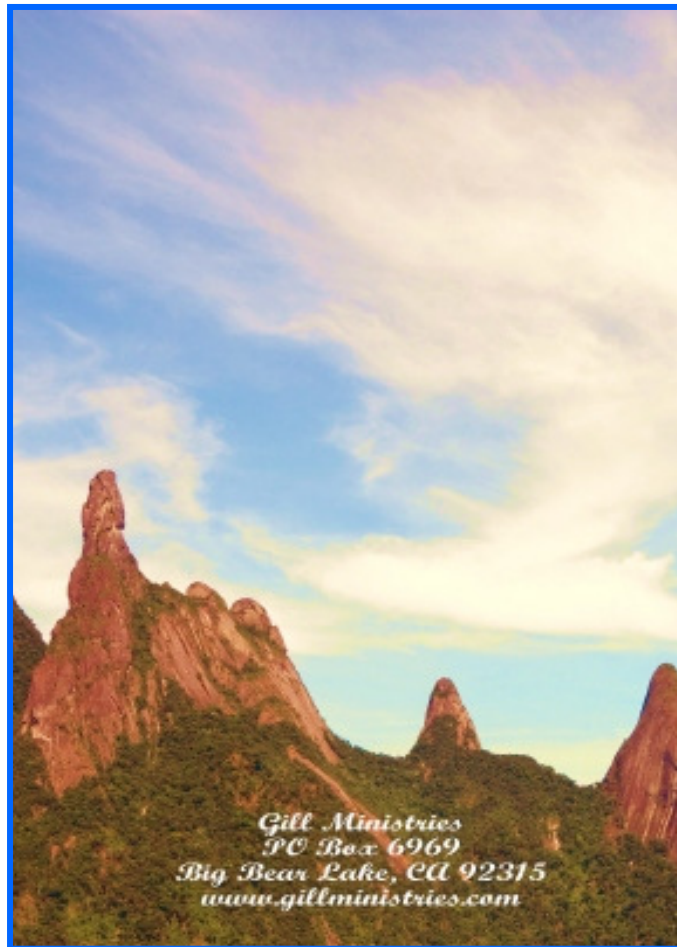
